(LEXINGTON - October 23, 2023) Multi-platinum, award-winning band blink-182 will be back on the road in the summer of 2024 with a stadium and arena tour through North America that will include a stop in downtown Lexington on Thursday, August 1 at Rupp Arena. Following the massive success of their colossal global outing and recent headlining festival performances at When We Were Young Festival, Mark Hoppus, Tom DeLonge, and Travis Barker will hit some of the biggest venues nationwide next year, debuting their new album <u>One More Time ...</u> for the first time in the U.S. and Canada.

Produced by Live Nation, the 30-city trek includes stadium performances at Petco Park in the band's hometown of San Diego, Sofi Stadium in Los Angeles, Citi Field in New York, Fenway Park in Boston, and Rogers Centre in Toronto, along with 25 arena performances. The band's new album, which currently features 2 number one singles in "Edging" and "One More Time", marks the first time in a decade that Mark, Tom and Travis have been in the studio together.
