LEXINGTON CENTER CORPORATION PUBLIC ASSEMBLY / EXPRESSIVE ACTIVITY POLICY

In order to define the rights of person or persons who wish to express their ideas/opinions relative to a particular subject on the property of Lexington Center Corporation, the following is LCC's policy relative to expressive activity. As a public assembly facility, Lexington Center Corporation can regulate expressive activity through reasonable time, place, and manner restrictions based upon conditions and regulations that are content-neutral, are narrowly tailored to serve a significant government interest (such as avoiding disruption of activities and protection of the public's safety and order), and leave open ample alternative channels for communication.

Individuals/organizations who wish to express their opinion on a specific subject may do so on the property of Lexington Center Corporation under the following criteria and conditions.

- Appropriate notice of such planned activity must be received in advance so that discussions can
 occur between the organization and the management of Lexington Center Corporation to review
 details of location, time and any designated restrictions (i.e., prohibition of sound amplification).
- Designated locations shall be pre-determined where such activity may occur. These locations are
 chosen to allow both ample visibility to the individuals who are expressing their opinion yet do not
 disrupt the general flow of patrons attending an event or of the general public doing business at or
 within the Central Bank Center or Lexington Opera House.
- The activity must not (a) unduly disrupt traffic, either vehicular or pedestrian; (b) create unreasonable safety risks; or (c) deface or destruct LCC property.
- Based upon the size (square footage) of each available location, there shall be reasonable restrictions as to the number of participants which can be placed in each location.
- Participants involved in the expressive activity must remain in the designated areas at all times.
- Sound reinforcement (i.e., megaphones, amplified microphones, etc.) is prohibited in all areas where such activity may occur.
