### LEXINGTON OPERA HOUSE ANNOUNCES SPECTACULAR LINEUP FOR THE UPCOMING SEASON

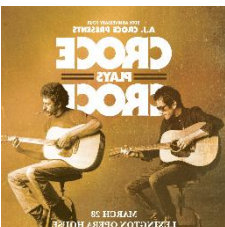
